## Registration

Registration begins March 5th for CA&NC Members and March 19th for Non-members. Call to reserve your camper's spot. You may pay at that time with a credit card or mail a check within the next two weeks. Your space is not guaranteed until payment is received. Registration forms will be sent to you and must be completed and returned to us before your child is fully enrolled in camp. Two weeks before camp begins, you will receive a list of camp activities and items to bring to camp. If camps are full when you call to reserve your space, you have the option to be put on a waiting list. If you cancel more than two weeks before camp you will receive an 85% refund. No refund will be given to those canceling less than two weeks before the first day of the camp session.
